William Garrett Hodges

It is with deep regret and sorrow that I write to you about the unexpected passing of our First Vice President, William Garret Hodges. William passed away suddenly at the age of 68 from the result of a boating accident on Tuesday, September 2, 2014.



William grew up on Ridgefield farm in Gordonsville, Orange County Virginia, the son of William Walton Hodges and Harriet Nicholls Garrett Hodges. He was a historian, art lover, musician, author, appraiser, and farmer who thoroughly enjoyed sharing his knowledge and expertise with others. He served his country faithfully in the United States Army with a tour in Germany. He has supplied various fine art pieces to the White House, the Vice President's Residence, and The Old Executive Office Building in Washington, D.C. Because of his expertise in antique appraising, he had served as an advisor/ appraiser to the FBI for successful recovery of rare items. In addition to being the Vice President and a member of the Board of Directors for the New Kent Historical Society, he was a board member for the Cultural Arts Center in Glen Allen, Va.

A graveside service will held Thursday, September 11th at Cedar Grove Cemetery, Williamsburg, VA at 11:00 am. A celebration of life service will follow at 1:00 p.m. at Vincent Funeral Home, 9923 Pocahontas Trail, Providence Forge, VA. The family will receive friends from 6-8 p.m., Wednesday, September 10th, at the funeral home. In lieu of flowers, contributions can be made to the New Kent Historical Society Museum, P.O. 
