

# About the "New" New Kent Historical Society Family History and Research Center

The "new" New Kent Historical Society (NKHS) Family History and Research Center is located in the Historic New Kent Courthouse District. We are housed in the old New Kent County Historic Jail constructed in 1909.

The purpose of the NKHS Family History and Research Center is to:

- Encourage, aid, and share research information
- Promote and educate others interested in genealogy and the history of New Kent
- Procure, preserve, publish, and distribute both genealogical and historical materials

We are steadily procuring additional research holdings which are made available for public use and for family and New Kent history research. We also offer for sale a growing list of our own publications pertaining to the history of New Kent, including portions of a few surrounding counties. Our goal is to provide resources to assist in research and the study of genealogy and the history of New Kent County, giving personal one-on-one professional assistance to our visitors.

The records of New Kent County were burned several times. However, we do have fragments of our early lost history. The research center has copies of wills, deeds, bible records, personal letters, memoirs, and other documents. Some of these are originals. Many of these copies and originals are so rare that you will not find them anywhere else.

When visiting the Research Center, you will meet Lavonne Allen, our Family Historian, who is waiting to assist you in a professional way. Whether you are a beginning or an advanced researcher, please bring as much information as you have about the ancestor/ancestors, place, or other subject you wish to research. This will make your visit more effective.

The NKHS Family History and Research Center is open each Monday from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm, except major holidays. Appointments outside of Mondays can be made with a 48 hour advance notice by calling 804-510-3826 or by emailing Lavonne at lavonne@newkenthistoricalsoc.com.


