- 5. Life in New Kent County during the war
- 6. A child growing up in New Kent County during the war
- 7. Leaving New Kent to find employment
- 8. Military personnel (from New Kent) who participated in World War II
- 9. A "ward" who lived at the Methodist Orphanage in Orapax
